



POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN SCHOOL COUNSELLING

Need:

The mission and vision of this School Counselling Program (SCP) is to prepare school counsellors who will utilise the professional knowledge, skills and practices necessary to promote the academic, career, personal and social development of the students.

Eligibility Criteria:

Masters in Psychology or Social Work or Special Education, working School Teachers with a post Graduate degree in their discipline along with a B.Ed and at least 2 years of work experience, those who have completed MBBS, BAMS, BHMS.

Duration of the course: One year

Fee: Rs. 30,000* + examination fee (approx. Rs. 2,000/-).

(*The fee can be paid in two instalments: Rs. 20,000 in the 1st semester and Rs. 10,000 in the 2nd semester.)

Mode of Learning: Hybrid

Contact/Offline Classes: For a duration of minimum 10 days where administering assessments will be taught. It is compulsory to attend these 10 days of contact classes.

Examination: Offline annual exam at the end of the course
