MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on this day Friday, 10th January 2025, ("Effective Date")

Between

SAM Global University (SGU), Raisen, Madhya Pradesh, India, a private university with its address at SAM Global University, Raisen- 464 551, Madhya Pradesh, India [hereinafter referred to as "Party A"].

And

LA PROTEINA SDN. BHD, Kuantan, Malaysia, and having its address at No-15, Lorong Padang Lalang 8, 25250, Kuantan, Pahang, Malaysia. [hereafter referred to as "Party B"].

Party A and Party B are hereafter collectively referred to as "Parties" and individually referred to as "Party".

WHEREAS:

- i Party A and Party B are desirous to collaborate/ associate themselves for educational, research, and social purposes in the field of research collaboration in the extraction and development of products from natural protein and other biotech areas. During the above collaboration, both Parties will follow the national biodiversity laws of respective countries and mutually agreed terms/ conditions between the Ministry of Science and Technology of both countries, if any.
- ii Both Parties agree to enter into this MoU to set forth the terms and understanding between the Parties.

A. NOW THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The two institutions will:
 - a) Cooperate in the exchange of information related to the Parties activities in teaching and research in areas of mutual interests. This can be done via training, workshops, webinars, international conferences, and symposiums, joint collaborative government and industrial projects.
 - b) Promote appropriate *joint research projects*, with particular emphasis on international funding.
 - c) Conduct short-term training courses (credit-based and non-credit-based courses) in online and offline mode, as mutually agreed in writing between the Parties prior to the commencement of the activity.
 - d) Conduct cultural projects or studies, as mutually agreed between the Parties prior to the commencement of the activity.
 - e) Conduct *study tours*, as mutually agreed between the Parties prior to the commencement of the activity.
 - f) The two institutions will give valuable inputs on curriculum modifications, will mutually work to train students on emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry-ready under skill development programs, will give guest lectures on mutually agreed topics, will conduct joint faculty development programs for their faculty members, will actively engage between themselves for exploring opportunities for student's internship/ dissertations.
- 2. Under this MoU, both institutions will work on developing an articulation agreement that SAM Global University, Raisen (SGU), graduates to apply for an internship program and Professional training at La Proteina Sdn. Bhd, Kuantan, Malaysia and vice-versa.
- 3. Under this MoU, both Parties are to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the programs on the terms specified herein.

- 4. Under this MoU, there is no financial commitment on the part of both the institutions to take up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt with separately.
- 5. The aim of the MoU shall be to achieve a broad balance in the respective contributions and benefits of the collaboration, and this shall be subject to periodic review by both universities.
- 6. The MoU shall be for a period of five years and shall be subject to renew based on mutually changing interest's/ focus areas of respective organizations.
- 7. Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both Parties have to discharge their obligations.
- 8. The focus area (if any) and the respective communicating personnel from both Universities are under-mentioned:
 - a. Dr. Rohit Sharma, Dean, Faculty of Sciences, SAM Global University (SGU), Raisen, Madhya Pradesh, India.
 - b. Dr Arun Gupta, Managing Director, La Proteina Sdn. Bhd, Kuantan, Malaysia.

The focus area would be:

- Biotechnology
- Development of cosmetic and pharmaceutical products from natural protein.
- Other related areas.
- Application of enzymes in optimizing the process.

B. EFFECT OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

1. Both Party A and Party B jointly declare that this MoU serves only as a record of the Parties intentions and does not constitute or create, and is not intended to constitute or create obligations under domestic or international law. This MoU will not give rise to any legal process, and will not be deemed to constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied.

- 2. This MoU will be used only for mutual cooperation for the educational, research, and social development of both organizations with prior consent or written agreement from both Parties on mutually agreed areas/ fields/ domains.
- 3. Both the Parties acknowledge that nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, create in either party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copyrights, and designs) of the other party.

C. REVISION, MODIFICATION AND AMENDMENT

- 1. Either Party may request in writing a revision, modification, or amendment of all or any part of this MoU.
- 2. Any revision, modification, or amendment agreed to by the Parties shall be in writing and shall form part of this MoU.
- Such revision, modification, or amendment shall come into force on such date as may be determined by the Parties by mutual agreement.
- 4. Any revision, modification, or amendment shall not prejudice the rights and obligations arising from or based on this MoU before or up to the date of such revision, modification, or amendment.

D. DURATION AND TERMINATION

- 1. This MoU shall come into force on the effective date and shall remain in force for a period of three (3) years subject to review and modification as mutually agreed upon.
- Thereafter, if the Parties hereto wish to extend the terms of this MoU, they shall do so by an express covenant in writing.
- 3. Notwithstanding anything in this Article, either Party may terminate this MoU by notifying the other Party its intention to terminate this MoU by a notice in writing, at least six (6) months prior to its termination date. Termination shall be without penalty.

4. Such notice of termination does not affect any individual students who have already commenced or been accepted by either Party for any of the programs mentioned in Section 1 above.

E. RELATIONSHIP OF THE PARTIES

- 2. Notwithstanding anything in this MoU, a Party shall at no time underwrite or guarantee or be in any way directly or indirectly responsible or deemed to be responsible for all or any of the debts, liabilities or obligations incurred by the other Party from time to time.

F. NOTICE

 Any communications under this MoU will be in writing in the English language and delivered by registered mail to the address of Party A or Party B as mentioned in this MoU or sent to the electronic mail address or facsimile number of Party A or Party B and shall unless otherwise provided herein, be deemed to be duly given or made when delivered to the recipient at such address or electronic mail address or facsimile number.

G. COUNTERPARTS

1. This MoU may be signed in a number of counterparts, each of which is original and all of which, taken together, constitutes one and the same document.

H. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION

 This MoU shall be governed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of both the countries i.e. India and the Malaysia and the Parties agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of, District Court of Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh, India and Jurisdiction of Kuantan Malaysia.

Between

SAM Global University (SGU), Raisen (Bhopal), Madhya Pradesh, India, a private university with its address at SAM Global University, Agariya Chopda, Bilkhiriya, Raisen-462021 (Bhopal), Madhya Pradesh, India [hereinafter referred to as "Party A"].

And

Universitas Siliwangi (UNSIL), Tasikmalaya, Indonesia, and having its address at Jalan Siliwangi Number 24, Kota Tasikmalaya, West Java, Indonesia, 46115. [hereafter referred to as "Party B"].

Party A and Party B are hereafter collectively referred to as "Parties" and individually referred to as "Party".

WHEREAS:

Party A and Party B are desirous of collaborating/associating themselves for educational, research, and social purposes in the Tri Dharma of Higher Education field, including Education, Research and Community Service. During the above collaboration, both



Parties will follow the national biodiversity laws of respective countries and mutually agreed terms/ conditions between the Ministry of Science and Technology of both countries, if any.

ii Both Parties agree to enter into this MoU to set forth the terms and understanding between the Parties.

A. NOW THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The two educational institutions will:

- 2. Under this MoU, both the educational institutions will work on developing an articulation agreement that SAM Global University, Raisen (Bhopal) (SGU), graduates to apply for admission to selected post-graduate degree programs at Universitas Siliwangi, Tasikmalaya, Indonesia. Admission to a specific department or course is subject only to a student being satisfactorily eligible/ qualified for the chosen area of study, fulfilling other admission requirements, and the availability of resources in the period for which admission is sought.
- Under this MoU, both the Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the programs on the terms specified herein.
- 4. Under this MoU, there is no financial commitment on the part of both the educational institutions to take up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt with separately.
- 5. The aim of the MoU shall be to achieve a broad balance in the respective contributions and benefits of the collaboration, and this shall be subject to periodic review by both universities.
- 6. The MoU shall be for a period of five years and shall be subject to renew based on mutually changing interests/ focus areas of respective organizations.
- 7. Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both Parties have to discharge their obligations.
- 8. The Parties agree to provide laboratory facilities and waive bench fees for faculty staff and students at the host university during the period of their exchange.
- 9. The focus area (if any) and the respective communicating personnel from both Universities are under-mentioned:
 - a. Dr. Rohit Sharma, Dean, Research and Development Cell/ International Relations Affairs, SAM Global University (SGU), Raisen (Bhopal), Madhya Pradesh, India.
 - b. Santiana, S.S., M.Pd., the Head of Centre for Cooperation and Alumni, Universitas Siliwangi, Tasikmalaya, Indonesia.



B. EFFECT OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

- 1. Both Party A and Party B jointly declare that this MoU serves only as a record of the Parties intentions and does not constitute or create, and is not intended to constitute or create obligations under domestic or international law. This MoU will not give rise to any legal process, and will not be deemed to constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied.
- 2. This MoU will be used only for mutual cooperation for the educational, research, and social development of both organizations with prior consent or written agreement from both Parties on mutually agreed areas/ fields/ domains.
- 3. Both the Parties acknowledge that nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, create in either party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copyrights, and designs) of the other party.
- 4. This MOU specifies general areas of potential cooperation. It is understood that the enactment of this MOU shall require specific governing conditions and frameworks. Additional Memorandum of Agreements detailing the governing conditions and framework, including financial agreements and other requirements, shall be agreed upon prior to the commencement of any activities.
- 5. This MOU shall enter into effect on the date the designated officials of the respective universities affix their signatures and shall remain in force for five (5) years unless either party proposes termination in a written notice at least six (6) months prior to the termination date. Under such circumstances, any ongoing activity under this MOU should be allowed for completion under the conditions applying when notice was given.

C. REVISION, MODIFICATION AND AMENDMENT

- 1. Either Party may request in writing a revision, modification, or amendment of all or any part of this MoU.
- 2. Any revision, modification, or amendment agreed to by the Parties shall be in writing and shall form part of this MoU.



- Such revision, modification, or amendment shall come into force on such date as may be determined by the Parties by mutual agreement.
- 4. Any revision, modification, or amendment shall not prejudice the rights and obligations arising from or based on this MoU before or up to the date of such revision, modification, or amendment.

D. DURATION AND TERMINATION

- 1. This MoU shall come into force on the effective date and shall remain in force for a period of three (3) years subject to review and modification as mutually agreed upon.
- 2. Thereafter, if the Parties hereto wish to extend the terms of this MoU, they shall do so by an express covenant in writing.
- 3. Notwithstanding anything in this Article, either Party may terminate this MoU by notifying the other Party its intention to terminate this MoU by a notice in writing, at least six (6) months prior to its termination date. Termination shall be without penalty.
